SENATOR WARNER: Mr. President, I move the amendment be adopted. All this amendment does is there was an error by E & R, it refers to five commissioners in Lancaster county and there are only three. It's relative to approval of a comprehensive plan. The entire amendment in E & R, number 6, which is stricken is not necessary, so I'm striking it in its entirety.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? Seeing none, the question is shall the amendment be stricken. Record your vote. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays on motion to adopt the Warner amendment.

SPEAKER: The Warner amendment has been adopted. Do you have another amendment Senator Warner?

SENATOR WARNER: I have a motion. I move the LB 111 be readvanced to E & R for engrossment.

SPEAKER: Motion has been made and seconded that LB 111 be advanced to E & R for enrollment. The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes on the motion to advance.

SPEAKER: Motion carried. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to return LB 66 for specific amendment. Signed, Senator Chambers. The specific amendment is to add the emergency clause.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this is really a non-controversial bill. It relates to the setting of fees by the Board of Barber Examiners. Without the emergency clause they will go broke and the bill, to have validity and effectiveness and accomplish its purpose, must have the emergency clause. I am a barber. I've talked to other barbers and there is no opposition to the bill. I ask that you bring it back to Select File and then vote to add the emergency clause.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? Seeing none, the question is shall the bill be returned. Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays on motion to return.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that the emergency clause be attached to LB 66.

SPEAKER: Do I hear a second? Any further discussion? If not, shall the emergency clause be attached to LB 66? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays on motion to adopt the Chambers amendment.
