PRESIDENT: What's your challenge, Senator?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That the Roll Call vote not be taken until the body determines that it should be taken so that would mean that the Roll Call vote not be taken at this time.

PRESIDENT: There has been a request for a Roll Call vote.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, there is a purpose for a Call of the House, that is to have the members present. I can understand your desire to expedite business but there is such a thing as seeing that a Rule is implemented and its purpose is carried out and I think that is the point that was being made.

PRESIDENT: Proceed with the Roll Call.

CLERK: Roll Call vote taken. See Page 860, Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Lewis, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Switching from aye to no for purpose of reconsideration.

CLERK: Senator F. Lewis changing from aye to no.

PRESIDENT: Announce the vote, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 20 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion for LB 122 to become law notwithstanding the Governor's veto failed. Senator Burbach.
