SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 78.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion of that motion? The question is the adoption of the amendments to LB 78. All those in favor say aye. Contrary nay. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Now Mr. President there's a request to bracket LB 78 for some further amendments. Signed, Senator Carsten.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, I would hope that we could bracket LB 78 for a short while. I'm not going to put a date certain on it, just bracket it because we do have some amendments to put on there that are not ready. I'd hope that we could hold it.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion of the motion? This requires 25 votes. Oh, you've asked for unanimous consent. Are there objections to the request to bracket LB 78? Seeing none, it is so ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, motion on the desk.

PRESIDENT: Proceed Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I move to return LB 529 to Select File for specific amendment. Signed, Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: There's a motion to return 529 to Select File for specific amendment. Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I would alert the body, Mr. President, that 529 is a very important bill because it's the Governor's emergency bill. It contains the emergency bonus for the National Guard, which has been causing quite a little bit of controversy. This amendment will just take a moment to bring back, adopt, then move 529 on. I got a motion up there to expedite 529. What the amendment does, this is at the request of the Department of Administrative Services, brings the bill back to change the amount of expenditures for revolving funds, basically on the Department of Administrative Services. If we don't do this because of an Attorney General's opinion we're not going to be able to print bills anymore. The limit which we thought did not put a ceiling on these funds, according to the Attorney General, now does put a ceiling on. Unless we raise that ceiling, which does not increase the tax expenditures. It simply raises the ceiling so that the subdivisions of the Department of Administrative Services can continue their operations. There are two amendments. Vince has them. I'd like to move that 529 be returned for this specific amendment, have it adopted, readvance the bill, and expedite it so we can vote on 529 before we go on Easter vacation.

PRESIDENT: The motion is to return LB 529 for specific amendment. Record your vote. Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 33 ayes, 0 nays, 16 not voting on motion to return the bill to Select File.
