CLERK: Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk reports that she did on this day at 9:00 a.m. present to the Governor for his approval 575, 489, 379, 271, 270, 220, 195 and 81. Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 193 and find the same correctly enrolled; LB 240 correctly enrolled; LB 529 correctly enrolled.
