SENATOR MARSH: Mr. Speaker, now that the Call is raised, I wonder if this might be a time to reconsider one of our recent rule changes.

CLERK: Mr. President, I ask to be excused at 2 o'clock until I return. Signed Senator Anderson. Senator Schmit asked to be excused. Senator Warner, Senator Carsten, Senator Clark and Senator Duis all asked to be excused this afternoon. Mr. President, Judiciary gives...refers LB 583 to General File as amended; LB 261 to General File as amended. Signed Miscellaneous Subjects Committee. Legislative Resolution 25 will be inserted in the Journal and be referred to the Executive Board. Mr. President, we have pending the Mills motion to reconsider our action on LB 310.

SPEAKER: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Yes.
