PRESIDENT: There's a request for unanimous consent to bracket LB 30. Are there objections? Seeing none it is so ordered.

Mr. Clerk read for the final time LB 67 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: Motion on the desk Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: I move to return LB 67 from Final Reading to Select File for specific amendment. Signed, Senator Clark. The specific amendment is attached to the motion to return.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Clark.

SENATOR CLARK: Mr. President, this is a bill we spoke about the other day that the REA's thought they were in a problem on, so we amended the bill. Then they find out there wasn't any problem, they want to put it back in the original condition it was. That's all the amendment does. I would ask to bring it back to Select File.

PRESIDENT: The question is returning LB 67 to Select File for specific amendment. Any further discussion? Record your vote. Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 1 nay, remainder not voting on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Clerk read, for the final time, LB 129.

CLERK: Read title.

PRESIDENT: Read the motion.

CLERK: I move to return LB 341 to Select File for the attached specific amendment. Signed, Senator Carsten.

PRESIDENT: Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President, members of the body, LB 341 has moved out of the committee and across the board without any problems at all. It got by some people that were directly involved with this bill before they finally caught it on Final Reading. I've come with a specific amendment that I can really see no serious problem with, as it reflects on the bill. You did have a letter from the American Grocery Manufacturing Association last Wednesday, explaining their position and the reasons for the amendment. For that reason I think that we do need to consider it, even though they were at fault for not catching the bill earlier. In all fairness to everyone I think we do owe them this privilege. I move to return it Mr. President.
