PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Bill is advanced. Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, we did pass over LB572. Because Senator Kremer is not here but I have been informed that there are no committee amendments so the next bill under consideration will be 572.

CLERK: Read LB572

PRESIDENT: Senator Moylan.

SENATOR MOYLAN: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this bill was thoroughly discussed last week. I have all kinds of statistics here on what the cost of these filings are. The purpose of the bill as you probably all know is to increase the amount of fees for replacement or duplication of copies of statistics...of certificate of title and also the fees charged for the refiling of such certificates. For each notation on any lean of certificate of title. It also provides for the distribution of these funds between the county and state general funds. Now these fees have not been changed for the past 14 years. Now the purpose of the increase now was to more nearly cover the expense for providing these services to the public. If there are no questions, I would move that LB572 be advanced to E & R for initial.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Question is the advancement of 572. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay.

PRESIDENT: Bill is advanced. Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature I do have a motion to adjourn on the desk. But I have had several requests the past few moments for LB470 which I have been assured will not be very controversial. Shall we take up 470.

PRESIDENT: Well we will test that. Let's try 470.

CLERK: Read LB470

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: Mr. President, members of the body, the committee amendments, all it does is to clean up the language. There was a duplication on line 2, it took out services or other aides, but this effects the bill in no way but did remove those three words. I would request the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Question is the adoption of the amendments to 470. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays and 23 not voting.
