SENATOR BURBACH: There is a motion on the desk to recess until 1:45. I do want to say that LB113 which is on our calendar will be the first order of business after we return from lunch. Then 198 will follow it. Senator Duis has a few remarks that he would like to make.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, it gives me great honor this afternoon at the convening time that the youngsters, a group of very fine youngsters from the Nebraska School of Trainable Mentally Retarded children will be here to give a concert on their bells for the legislature. It will not last very long, but I think that you will be interested. They have just finished making a tape for ETV and also producing a program for Channel 10 this morning and they are going to be here at 1:30 for us this afternoon and I thank you for your attendance.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Marsh.
