PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the Legislature reconsider its previous action on LB 528. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 10 nays, 9 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The bill shall be reconsidered. Senator Koch, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR KOCH: A point of special privilege, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: State your point to the Chair.

SENATOR KOCH: My point is, it is just too bad Social Security program isn't under our insurance companies. It wouldn't be in the problem...it doesn't have the problem it has today.

PRESIDENT: That is out of order, Senator. The Chair is happy to announce that in the North balcony, we have 39 Ninth and Twelfth Grade students from Franklin, Nebraska here. They come from Senator Gary Anderson's area and also Senator Swigart has two very prominent guests here, Larry Brown, President of the Omaha PTA and Mrs. Pool, who is a member of the Legislative Committee of the Omaha PTA. Welcome to all of you people. Thank you for coming.

CLERK: Mr. President, your Banking Committee to whom was referred LB 109 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation that it be indefinitely postponed.
