PRESIDENT: Senator Syas, do you want to..

SENATOR SYAS: Just to ask the Chair a question. Is 23 back there now and the E & R amendments?

CLERK: No, we're on 198.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis is not around and we haven't found Senator Goodrich. If there is no objection, the Chair would like to pass both of these bills, then, and we can return to them. Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: No. Go ahead. Take care of them and then I would like to speak.

PRESIDENT: We must work this agenda and because these Senators aren't here, let's pass over these two bills and go right to Senator Anderson's motion on LB 367.

CLERK: What about 341. 341 is bracketed for today. Bracketed specifically for today. Mr. President, LB 341 had been correctly engrossed and it has now been returned to Select File. There is a motion to amend on Select File, which was bracketed for today, and there is then a request to withdraw by the introducer.

PRESIDENT: All right. Senator Carsten.

SENATOR CARSTEN: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, we did bracket 341 for today on Select File and in the interim here, we have had a meeting and done some further discussion on the amendment and the bill, itself, and we are now informed that the problem that we were trying to correct can be corrected with present statute, if it is enforced, and that is exactly what happened. So I am asking unanimous request to withdraw 341.

PRESIDENT: All right. That will be laid over, then, Senator, and we have just been advised that Senator Goodrich would like unanimous consent for 466 to be laid over also until Wednesday. So that takes care of Select File with the exception of...

CLERK: No, I have some more.

PRESIDENT: All right.

CLERK: 4/16, Goodrich wants 466 laid over until 4/16, right? Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to unbracket 226. Signed Senator Kime.

PRESIDENT: You have heard the motion. Need there be discussion? Is there an objection to the unbracketing of 226? Seeing none, it is...all those in favor say aye. Contrary nay. It is unbracketed.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, there are E & R amendments to LB 266, 226.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, I move that the E & R amendments be adopted to 226.
