SENATOR STULL: Now I move LB 252, as amended, to E & R final.

SENATOR SAVAGE: LB 252. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed no. The motion carries.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President, I move the E & R amendments to 960 be adopted.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Amendments to 960. All those in favor . . .

SENATOR STULL: LB 96.

SENATOR SAVAGE: 296? Alright 96. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed no. The amendments to LB 96 . . .

SENATOR STULL: Now I move 96 be advanced to E & R final for engrossing, as amended.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to advance LB 96. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed no. Motion carried.

SENATOR STULL: I move 198A be advanced to E & R final for engrossing.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to advance LB 198A to . . . Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I'm going to have to amend this down a little bit. The fiscal analyst has gotten together with Judge Novicoff. They now agree on a sum for next year. If you could just lay it over until the end I'll have the proper amendment.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Are you asking for unanimous consent?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Right. I'll have it in about five minutes.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Any objections? So ordered.

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President, I move that the amendments to 317 be adopted.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to adopt the amendments to LB 317. All those in favor signify by saying aye. Opposed no.

CLERK: Mr. President, there's an amendment offered by Senator Duis. On page 6, line 20, after "regulation" insert "which are in force as of the effective date of this act". Signed, Senator Duis.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, and Senator Bereuter, this is the amendment which I mentioned at the time which would restrict the State Planning Department to this particular date on their rules that went into it. They couldn't make other rules that were more enforceable after that particular date, if you recall Senator Bereuter. If there's any objection Senator Bereuter could make it now. If not, why I ask that the amendment be adopted.
