SENATOR SAVAGE: There's a motion on the desk to recess. I have two lights on and if you wish to continue debate, I'll call on Senator Koch. Alright. Motion to recess.

CLERK: We have a request for unanimous consent to bracket 306 signed, Senator Mills.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Any objections? So ordered.

CLERK: Mr. President, unanimous consent to print amendments in the Journal to LB 187. Signed, Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Do I hear any objections? So ordered.

CLERK: Legislative resolution 30 will be inserted in the Journal. A committee statement from the Government Committee will be inserted in the Journal. A committee statement from the Committee on Committees will be inserted in the Journal.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I announce to the Legislature that the Appropriations Committee will meet in Room 2102 from noon to probably till 6 o'clock. So when we need to vote you can come and call on us. We've moved upstairs so we can be as close to this room as possible. We need . . . we've set the hearing for noon and it will continue probably till 6 this evening.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Motion to recess. All those in favor. Opposed.
