PRESIDENT: Senator Stull, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR STULL: Mr. President and members of the Legislature, I am going to move to have this bill bracketed until Monday. I don't think it is going to pass without the Barnett amendment and we need this bill. I think we are going to have to have some compromise and I would move to bracket it until Monday until we can get together and work out a satisfactory amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the bill be bracketed until Monday? Record your vote. Have you voted. Record. Senator Stull.

SENATOR STULL: I am afraid I am going to have to ask for a Call of the House, and roll call, please.

PRESIDENT: All Senators are required to be in their chairs, and everybody is here except the man who raised the point that nobody is in their chairs, Senator Savage.

SENATOR STULL: Roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: You are asking for a roll call vote, Senator.

SENATOR STULL: Yes sir.

PRESIDENT: Call the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. See Page 1419 and 1420, Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: I move to suspend the vote until Savage gets back on the floor. He is the 25th vote.

PRESIDENT: Will the Sergeant at Arms open that door back there and advise Senator Savage that he is needed. Senator Mills is deputized. Would all Senators please take their chairs? We are commencing a roll call vote. Commence the roll.

CLERK: Roll call vote continued. 27 ayes, 18 nays, 4 not voting on the motion to bracket, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion carries. We move off of Final Reading. The Senators may leave their chairs. The Chair is going to leave its chair, too. Temporarily, Senator Lewis.

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 187 and recommend it be placed on Select File as amended, 187A on Select File and 269 on Select File as amended. Signed Senator Dworak, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and...on Agriculture and Environment reports we have examined LB 203 and recommend it be advanced to General File as amended, 433 General File as amended, 514 General File as amended and 357 indefinitely postponed. Signed Senator Schmit, Chairman. Mr. President, we are ready for Select File.
