SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I move the advancement of the bill to E & R.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is the advancement of LB 333. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. LB 310.

CLERK: Read title. Mr. President, the bill was first considered on March 18th and indefinitely postponed. Then, Mr. President, the bill was reconsidered on the . . . March 26th it was reconsidered.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move this bill be moved from General File to E & R initial. I'll be glad to answer any questions if there. There was an amendment which every member has a copy of the amendment clarifying the wording. This is the amendment we used when we brought it up to reconsider. This is just a refresher. I move that it be moved from General File to E & R initial.

CLERK: Well now wait. There are amendments on it, Mr. President. I have two separate amendments from Senator Dworak, but I think they're the same thing.

SENATOR DWORAK: Yeah, mine just says . . . I just distributed the amendments so it would be in front of everybody.

CLERK: Do you want to adopt that?

SENATOR DWORAK: Please.

PRESIDENT: Read the amendment Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read amendment found on page 1466 in Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak do you wish to speak on your amendment?

SENATOR DWORAK: No, I'll just answer any questions if there are any. I move the amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Senator Shirley Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Question for Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Yes.

SENATOR MARSH: Why did you decide, after the bill was introduced, to make this change?

SENATOR DWORAK: I think we had . . . the problem we had with the bill on the word . . . we were taking out the word "undisclosed" only on page 2. That was the initial intent of the bill. This resulted in a lot of confusion as to exactly what we're doing. So actually with the amendment . . . and I think there's a copy of that amendment in front of you. This is clarifying . . . essentially
