SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I would make a suggestion that beings we are automatically under Call of the House, if we are not, and I see Senator Simpson shaking his head, that the Sergeant at Arms be instructed to find out where the absent members are but I always thought you had to get a Call of the House. It is only a requirement that you be here. I don't believe that we are automatically under.

PRESIDENT: Do you move that we have a roll call, Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: I would ask for a Roll call vote.

PRESIDENT: All right. Roll call vote. All Senators please take your chairs and the Sergeant at Arms, please see if you can find anyone around. We are not under.... well, whatever we are under, we are under.

CLERK: Roll call vote taken. See Page 1472, Journal.

PRESIDENT: Could you find Senator Dworak, one of the Sergeant at Arms? Oh, excuse me.

CLERK: Roll call vote continued. Senator Simpson changing from no to aye. 33 ayes, 5 nays, 11 not voting, Mr. President. 33, 5, and 11.

PRESIDENT: LB 371 passes with the emergency clause attached. Mr. Clerk, please read on Final Reading LB 418 with the emergency clause attached.

CLERK: Engrossed LB 418.

(RECORDER TURNED OFF FOR FINAL READING OF LB 418.)

PRESIDENT: We move from Final Reading to Select File. We commence with...

CLERK: Senator DeCamp's asked to have some amendments to 349 inserted in the Journal. That's all.

PRESIDENT: We start with 307 on Select File. The Chair recognizes Senator Dworak. Could you advise, Mr. Clerk, on 307.

SENATOR DWORAK: I move the adoption of the Enrollment and Reveiw ameindments to LB 307.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of the motion. All those in favor say aye. Contrary nay. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 307 be advanced to Enrollment and Review for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion of the motion. The question is, the advancement of 307? All those in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 217.
