PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Record your presence.

CLERK: Senator Kime asked to be excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Have you recorded your presence? Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: None Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections from the floor? Seeing none, the Journal shall stand. Committee hearings and reports.

CLERK: Read communication from Congressman Charles Thone. Communication is on file in the Clerks office.

Read E & R report. LB 187, 32, 50, 50A, 235, 381, 560, 452, 395, 446, 333 and 150 all on Select File as amended.

PRESIDENT: We now go to Final Reading. I ask that all Senators take their chairs and all other people please leave the Legislative floor. We have one bill only on Final Reading, LB 588, with the emergency clause attached. Would you please read it Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Read LB 588.

PRESIDENT: Do we have anything on Select File Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Apparently not Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Alright, we will move directly to General File. Chair recognizes the Speaker, Senator Burbach.

SPEAKER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, as I indicated to you yesterday afternoon, LB 443 and 443A were bills which were set up for discussion this morning. The introducer, Senator Fowler, is having lengthy and a series of amendments and they are not ready at this time. He is putting them together in bill form. But because we didn't have hardly any Final Reading, only one bill this morning, it won't be here for an hour or maybe an hour and a half. So we are starting then on LB 204 and Senator Chambers asks to pass that one over so we are ready for LB 215.

PRESIDENT: Then we will come back to LB 443.

SPEAKER: When Senator Fowler's amendments do arrive.

PRESIDENT: Yes, and that meets with your approval Senator Chambers to pass over 204?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes.

CLERK: Read LB 215.
