SENATOR KELLY: Thank you very much.

SPEAKER: No further lights on, so the motion now is to advance LB 417 as amended to E & R Initial. Record your vote.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye.

SPEAKER: Have you all voted? Senator Swigart voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Swigart voting aye.

SPEAKER: You have to vote on the machine, Senator. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 1 nay to advance the bill, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: LB 417 is advanced as amended. The next bill is 477. Senator Skarda. There is an A bill. I am sorry. I will call on you in just a minute, Senator Skarda.

CLERK: LB 417A introduced by Senators Luedtke and Cavanaugh. Read title.

SPEAKER: Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Mr. President, it is my bill.

SPEAKER: Senator Luedtke. Senator Cavanaugh had his light on, Senator Luedtke.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: Let me move it first and then he will have to amend it because the A bill will not be correct the way it is. It will have to be amended.

SPEAKER: Go ahead.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: But let's move the bill and then have the amendment.

SPEAKER: Proceed.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: I move that it be advanced to E & R Initial.

SPEAKER: Now, Senator Cavanaugh, do you wish to speak? Motion is to advance 417A to E & R Initial. Record your vote.

SENATOR LUEDTKE: I move that it be advanced and then we can amend it on Select File. Mr. President, also I move that both of these bills be expedited. I ask for unanimous consent they both be expedited.

SPEAKER: Do I see any objections? So ordered. Senator Koch.

SENATOR KOCH: Mr. Speaker and members of the body, I am as much for 417 as anyone else in here but there are other bills
