PRESIDENT: Senator Koch. Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: Mr. President, because Senator Marvel had asked . . . they're not quite prepared on 571. I had talked to Senator Richard Lewis earlier and I had felt that the thing had been pretty well cleared. We'll drop that and we'll just move right along with priority bills, it will be Senator Barnett, 237.

CLERK: What number?

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Swigart.

SENATOR SWIGART: Mr. President, while he's getting the thing together could I rise to a point of personal privilege?

PRESIDENT: Well state your point.

SENATOR SWIGART: It has to do with the Pages. I wanted to pay a compliment.

PRESIDENT: Alright.

SENATOR SWIGART: While we're waiting, and he's kind of getting together there. You know we have but 17 days left and I wanted to get this in. It's an enthusiastic word, warm compliment on behalf of the Pages and their work. I think when I'm through that you'll hear a hand which will verify that the other Senators feel the same way about what the Pages have been doing for us during this session. The words of compliment that I want to use are these: cheerful, very courteous, quick to respond, thorough, knowledgable, and very friendly service. Will you give them a hand.
