PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: I call for the previous question.

PRESIDENT: Are there five seconds? The question is, shall debate cease. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 2 nays.

PRESIDENT: Debate ceases. Senator Marvel would you close debate on the request 861.

SENATOR MARVEL: I renew my motion to get premission of the committee to have the bill introduced.

PRESIDENT: This takes 30 votes. Record your vote. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 2 nays, 12 not voting.

Mr. President, LB 610. Read title.

Motion on the desk Mr. President. I move that Rule 3, Section 5 be suspended and that LB 610 be placed on General File without a public hearing. Signed, Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: The question is the suspension of the rules. Are you ready for the vote? Record. Have you voted? Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 2 nays.

Mr. President, Senator Kelly asks unanimous consent to print amendments in the Journal to LB 507.

Mr. President, LB 608. Read title. There are no amendments.

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. Chairman, I'd ask that be laid over.

PRESIDENT: Motion to lay the bill over. Is there an objection? Seeing none, it's so ordered.

CLERK: Read title to LB 609.

PRESIDENT: Alright there are no amendments. The Chair will recognize Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: This is . . . I move that the bill be advanced to E & R initial. This is a bill that takes care of fire safety, life safety, the preservation of the present facilities, air conditioning. These are the major areas. I'd like to go through them just briefly. Air conditioning, under the Department of Public Institutions, is on pages 2 and 3. The fire safety provisions are on page 4.
