SENATOR DUIS: I'm not concerned as to who they're adopted by. It should be in the statute as to what an illegal well is, not a rule and regulation. That's the point I'm getting at.

SENATOR KREMER: Senator Duis, not if you expect local control. If you want the local group to do it why not give them the authority to adopt their own rules and regulations?

SENATOR DUIS: You know let's don't you and I get in an argument over local control.

SENATOR KREMER: Mr. Chairman, I wonder if we could move this bill ahead . . .

SPEAKER: Of course.

SENATOR KREMER: I'll be glad, Mr. Chairman, to get together with other people. If it moves on I'll be glad to take care of anything we possibly can.

SPEAKER: We have before us the Rasmussen amendment. Any further discussion of that? Senator Rasmussen do you care to close.

SENATOR RASMUSSEN: No closing.

SPEAKER: The question is shall the Rasmussen amendment be adopted. Have you all voted? Shall the Rasmussen amendment be adopted to LB 577? Have you all voted? The Clerk will record.

CLERK: 12 ayes, 14 nays.

SPEAKER: The amendment fails. Any other amendments Mr. Clerk? What will we do with the bill Senator Kremer?

SENATOR KREMER: I move it be advanced.

SPEAKER: Any discussion? If not, the question is shall LB 577 be advanced to E & R initial. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Senator Marvel, are you ready with 610.

CLERK: Mr. President, I ask unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 522.

Mr. President, LB 610?

SPEAKER: Right.

CLERK: Read title.
