SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Marsh.

SENATOR MARSH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. We're trying to move 611 along. If we have taken care of another bill by the time this gets to Select File, and it is then the time this should be removed, I'll help remove it. Right now let's not take anymore amendments. Let's move 611 from General File to E & R initial. Please reject this proposed amendment and let's move the bill.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion on the Koch amendment? Seeing no further discussion, the question is shall the Koch amendment be adopted. Have you all voted? Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 11 ayes, 23 nays.

SPEAKER: The amendment is not adopted.

CLERK: That's all the amendments I have Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Syas.

SENATOR SYAS: (mic inactivated) ... bill then, then I'll have a comment.

SPEAKER: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move that 611 be advanced to E & R initial.

SPEAKER: Any further discussion? Senator Marvel. Senator Syas, Chair recognizes you now.

SENATOR SYAS: All I was going to say, can't we, ladies and gentlemen, on these next bills merely put them over on Select File and argue the amendments then, so we can ... we're slap-happy already. We're not really legislating. Can't we just advance the bill because they have to be advanced, and catch them on Select File with all amendments, without going through ever ... We're going to be here till midnight at the way we're going. We're not legislating. It's been a long day.

SPEAKER: Chair recognizes Senator Anderson. I'm sorry. Question before the House, shall the bill be advanced. Chair recognizes Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Who moved to cease debate, Senator? Why are we limiting debate on this bill on a motion to advance? It's debatable.

SPEAKER: Chair saw a little more debate. I'm sorry, I did call on Senator Syas. Senator Marvel made the motion and then I saw no more debate so I called for the question.
