SPEAKER: Senator Marvel, do you have any closing statements on this bill? None. The question is, shall LB 611 be advanced to E & R for initial. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

SPEAKER: Bill is advanced. Chair recognizes Senator Marvel on LB 610.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 610. Read title. There are no committee amendments. Mr. President, a motion on the desk.

SPEAKER: Read the motion. Members of the Legislature, there is a motion on the desk to adjourn. I would like to point out to you that you have a deadline tonight of having these bills off of General File. I know it needs discussion and I know we'll need to discuss it at some time. We have many other bills to consider. If you will advance the bill, discuss it on Select File, it doesn't save much time but it does save a day or so time on E & R for initial. Move it along. I would be hopeful that we could in some way take under consideration LB 610 tonight. If would withhold some of the amendments, some of the discussion to Select File I think we can proceed and accomplish the desired goals for these bills to have an opportunity for this body to override. Chair recognizes Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Mr. President, I would move that LB 610 ... rather 611 be advanced from General File to E & R initial ... 610 I'm sorry. I looked at the board and it was wrong, 610. That LB 610 will be discussed on Select File as if it was on General File.

SPEAKER: It is that way already, Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Fine, but I thought I'd put it into the record that way so that we would know that it would be discussed on Select File as if it was on General File.

SPEAKER: Any discussion on the Duis motion? Senator Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Mr. President, I rise to oppose the Duis motion. I think I said exactly what was going to happen when we introduced the bill the last time, that we would try to move that over to Select File. The game plan is just working exactly right. I want the record clear that we don't plan to debate an \$80 million bill which is a full 25% of the total appropriation in this state, and we're going to pass it over carte blanche. I have some amendments on there. I am prepared to discuss them this evening. I suggested earlier we did not take up the bill. There were those that wanted to take them up. That bill contains about three or four things that are totally unacceptable. Again the issue of community technical schools that I mentioned to you at that point in time is totally funded in there at \$19 million. I think the legitimate thing for us to do now is to either be prepared for full debate on this issue on General File, or we adjourn. Now there is 40 other
