PRESIDENT: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer.

PRESIDENT: Roll call. Record your presence. Record Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Quorum present Mr. President.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Dickinson wishes to be excused until he arrives. Senator Skarda asks to be excused tomorrow. Senator Swigart asks to be excused at quarter till eleven until he returns.

PRESIDENT: Any corrections?

CLERK: None, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Are there corrections to the Journal from the floor? Seeing none, the Journal shall stand. Committee reports.

CLERK: Mr. President, you committee on E & R reports that we have examined LB449, and recommend that it be replaced on Select File as amended.

That is all Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Were ready for Final Reading. Would all senators please take your chairs. Anyone but Senators please leave the Legislative floor. Mr. Clerk commence Final Reading by reading LB32. (machine turned off)

CLERK: Senator Mahoney and Savage ask to be excused tomorrow.

Mr. President, I move that we suspend the rules and consider LB306 and 381 set for May 9th today May 8th. Signed Senator Wiltse.

PRESIDENT: What are the numbers of the bills?

CLERK: 306 and 381.

PRESIDENT: Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, a request has been made of me that we do take up tomorrows one bill on tomorrows final reading. I would move that 381 also be included and I know that you have read it so we will conclude tomorrows reading only 2 bills. That is all that we have for tomorrow so lets finish them up today so we can move along.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall the rules be suspended, specifically rule 6, section 6, for the purpose of taking two bills out of order. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays to suspend the rules.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries, rules are suspended. Mr. Clerk please take up out of order.....
