PRESIDENT: Senator Dickinson, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR DICKINSON: Did he say me?

PRESIDENT: Well, yes, you had your light on.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I surely do. I just want to make one statement...

PRESIDENT: Well, he was closing, Senator.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I think a statement Senator Lewis made needs to be corrected for the sake of the whole body.

PRESIDENT: That may be true but your light didn't...I announced Senator Cavanaugh was closing and your light came on while he was speaking.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Are you sure about that?

PRESIDENT: Well, yes, I made sure of it.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Well, anyway, I prefer to think (inaudible).

PRESIDENT: Senator, we can't have debate after close. The question is the adoption of the Cavanaugh amendment. Record your vote. Have you voted? There is a request for a record vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: Record vote read. See Page 1763, Journal. 16 ayes, 22 nays, 11 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion fails.

CLERK: Another amendment offered by Senator Marvel.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is that the one that transfers the Psyc Institute to the Med Center.

CLERK: Yes.

SENATOR MARVEL: OK. What this amendment does is simply carry out fiscally what you have approved in LB 466. I move the adoption of the amendment.

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? The question is, the adoption of this amendment to LB 605. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 0 nays. Mr. President, that is all the amendments I have on LB 605.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: I move the bill be advanced to E & R.

PRESIDENT: Discussion. All those in favor say aye. Contrary nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, there were four bills that were returned which are on an expedite list starting with LB 417.
