CLERK: 14 ayes, 22 nays.

PRESIDENT: The Chair is not sustained and the Chair recognizes Senator Savage to speak to the amendment.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. All this additional \$90,000 does is to show our sincerity in trying to accomplish a building in downtown Omaha. We're not going to spend this money until the building has a program presented under the rules of LB 1048. It will not be spent. I thought maybe we could get by, originally, with the \$10,000. Apparently, the donor will not commit his \$2 1/2 million, and the \$2 1/2 million from the business people of Omaha without our having a substantial amount in this fund to prove our sincerity. I hope that we don't let this \$5 million, that will help build this needed building in Omaha, go down the drain.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of Senator Mahoney's amendment. Record your vote. Please vote. Speaking of time, we do use a lot of time going under Call and the Chair begging for votes. Have you all voted? Record. Senator Mahoney.

SENATOR MAHONEY: May I have a Call of the House?

PRESIDENT: Yes. The question is shall the House go under Call. Record. Clear the board Vince. Would you please vote on whether to go under Call or not. Record.

CLERK: 23 ayes, 8 nays.

PRESIDENT: We're under Call. All Senators please take your chairs. Record your presence. Senator Syas would you record your presence. Fitzgerald, Stull, Nichol, Senator Swigart.

CLERK: Senator Marvel voting no on the original motion. Senator Mills changing from no to aye on the original motion.

PRESIDENT: Would the Sergeant-at-Arms find Senator Chambers please.

CLERK: Senator Dworak voting no on the original motion. Senator Johnson voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall the Call be raised. Record your vote. Clear the board. Record and report the vote.

CLERK: 29 ayes to raise the Call.

PRESIDENT: Report the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 13 nays, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries.
