PRESIDENT: Senator Goodrich. No, alright. The question is the adoption of Senator DeCamp's motion to return the bill to Select File for specific amendment. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 2 ayes, 38 nays on the motion to return, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The motion fails. Alright, on Final Reading LB 123 again. Please stay in your chairs.

CLERK: Read title. (mic inactivated).

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I'd like some procedural information if I might.

PRESIDENT: Yes sir.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: In a move to reconsider to put the emergency clause on, does the bill have to be taken back? Can it be done that way again?

PRESIDENT: Well it failed to get the majority vote. You mean the motion to reconsider?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: For the emergency clause.

PRESIDENT: The emergency clause was on the bill. It was on Final Reading, Senator.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Well my question is to the Clerk for help. If we move to reconsider and then we got the 33 votes, would that have any effect on the bill being moved on right now?

PRESIDENT: . . . moved to reconsider . . . this bill passes now. Announce the vote, yeah.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 13 nays, 6 not voting, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Senator Keyes, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR KEYES: Mr. Speaker, might I inform Senator Frank Lewis that the bill has an effective date of January 1, 1975 and the emergency clause means nothing on the bill.

PRESIDENT: Next. (mic inactivated) LB 328.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 328 was considered this morning. There is now pending on LB 328 a motion by Senator F. Lewis. Senator Lewis' motion reads as follows: to add a new section. It would say "At least 10 percent of all highway safety funds shall be used for motorcycle safety". Signed, Senator F. Lewis.

PRESIDENT: That's a motion to return to Select File, Senator?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Yeah.
