PRESIDENT: LB 368 passes. Very happy to welcome in the north balcony some students from Senator Carsten's district. We have 48 4th grade students from Park School in Plattsmouth. Thank you all for coming. We appreciate student groups visiting the Legislature.

CLERK: Mr. President, Select File LB237, yes can we take it? (mike turned off) there are E and R amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB237.

PRESIDENT: Question is shall the amendments be adopted to 237. All those in favor say aye, contrary no. Amendments are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that 237 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You heard the question. All those in favor say aye, contrary no. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President I move that LB237A be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The bill is advanced. Senator Mills do you want a machine vote on that?

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB142.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary no. The amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Now Mr. President there is a motion to indefinitely postpone LB142. That Mr. President, should lay over one day.

PRESIDENT: Alright, the next bill.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President...

CLERK: Oh, I'm sorry, signed by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments...

CLERK: Mr. President, Speaker Burbach suggested that we not take up 325. Mr. President; LB74 was returned to Select File this morning for an E & R amendment which can be considered.
