CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on E & R reports that we have examined and reviewed 604, 609, 610, 611, and 612 all correctly enrolled.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I have signed LB 604, 609, 610, 611 and 612.

CLERK: Mr. President your committee on E & R reports that we have examined 344 and recommend that it be replaced on select File as amended. 328, 589, 380, 567, 557, 288, 279, placed on Select File as amended.

Mr. President previously asked that we could take up these bills at this time.

PRESIDENT: Are there objections? So ordered.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB344.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. Any discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB344 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? The question is the advancement of 344. All those in favor say aye, those opposed nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB328.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. Any discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. The amendments are adopted.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB328 be advanced to E & R for Engrossment.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. The bill is advanced.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB589.

PRESIDENT: You heard the motion. Discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. Amendments are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a series of amendments on 589. The first one is offered by Senator Warner. Read.
