PRESIDENT: Question is shall LB 74 be returned to Select File for specific amendment. Record. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on motion to return.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: I move for the adoption of the amendment. The amendment is adding the emergency clause which was inadvertantlt left out in the drafting.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion is adopted. Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Mr. President, I move that LB 74 be advanced to E & R for engrossment.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. Discussion? All those in favor say aye, contrary nay. The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that the Clerk of the Legislature be directed to request of the Governor the return of LB 368 to the Legislature so the body may reconsider its action on the same. Signed, Senator Mills. 368A.

SENATOR MILLS: Mr. President, members of the body. I think we've acted, this morning, showing what we want to do. I think it's imparative we bring the bill back. We've been criticized in the papers. We've been criticized by our constituents. I think we ought to bring this bill back and reconsider our action.

PRESIDENT: Senator Frank Lewis.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: No!

PRESIDENT: Further discussion? Senator Barnett.

SENATOR BARNETT: Yes!

PRESIDENT: Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: No!

PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Duis.

SENATOR DUIS: Well I'm a little more serious about this. I think the Governor can do as he pleases over there. I don't think it's necessary for us to help him make up his mind. We sent the bill over there. Let's leave it with him to see what he'll do.
