SENATOR MURPHY: I'm sorry. May we have the roll call vote, Call of the House.

PRESIDENT: Call of the House. The question is shall the House go under Call. Record. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays.

PRESIDENT: We're under Call. Please take your chairs and record your presence promptly.

CLERK: Senator Simpson voting aye on the original motion. Senator Burbach voting aye on the original motion. Senator Anderson voting aye on the original motion. Senator Keyes voting aye on the original motion. Senator Rumery voting no on the original motion. Senator Wiltse voting aye on the original motion. Senator Johnson voting aye.

PRESIDENT: Senator Marsh, for what purpose do you arise?

SENATOR MARSH: To ask how you can tell whose here and whose not when we don't check in with a roll call? When we don't punch our buttons. After we're under Call of the House you normally ask us to record our presence.

PRESIDENT: I did Senator.

SENATOR MARSH: Sorry.

PRESIDENT: The question is shall the Call be raised. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 3 nays.

PRESIDENT: The Call is raised. Report the vote.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 8 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. Next bill.
