PRESIDENT: Yes, on the amendment, yes sir. Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Burbach.

SENATOR BURBACH: I move to advance LB 180A to E & R for initial. As I agreed with Senator Dickinson, we will take a look at it on Select File if he so desires at that time.

PRESIDENT: OK. You've heard the motion. Record your vote. Senator Skarda.

SENATOR SKARDA: I just want to know what you're going to do with that kill motion I had? You never did anything, Mr. President. I ask unanimous consent that it be withdrawn. I am in full support of Senator Burbach and the amendment we adopted. We accomplish the saving of the State of Nebraska of \$300,000 with little or no effort, so we did make some headway. You better withdraw the kill motion.

PRESIDENT: The Clerk advises me that somewhere or other it's already been done, Senator Skarda.

SENATOR BURBACH: I believe Senator Skarda made a request to hold his kill motion until

PRESIDENT: Alright. Is there any objection? Seeing none, it's withdrawn. Record your vote on the advancement of the bill. Record.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

SENATOR BURBACH: I'd like to ask unanimous consent that we unbracket LB 202 which was originally set up ... after yesterday the decision was made to hold it till the 29th of January. We have some time available this afternoon. I do have the amendment on the Clerk's desk. I have an amendment here. I would like to explain it in just a moment. I ask that we unbracket it now.

CLERK: Read title to LB 202. Mr. President, there are Committee amendments which were adopted. Mr. President, the Committee amendments have been adopted. The bill was indefinitely postponed on March 11th of last year. The bill was then reconsidered and placed on General File. There are now amendments pending from Senator Burbach which read as follows: (Read amendment found on page 230 of Journal).

SENATOR BURBACH: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. In view of the statements that were made on the floor this afternoon of real concern about economy, Senator Dickinson expressed it in LB 180A. I have the same concern. I think that the majority of this body, and probably a very heavy majority of this body, does feel this way.
