PRESIDENT: We go back to General File. LB 398. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 398 has been first considered on January 14th, 1976. It is a bill for an act introduced by Senator Schmit. Read title. Mr. President, there are some Committee amendments by Senator Murphy's Banking, Commerce and Insurance Committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy.

SENATOR MURPHY: This bill relating to branch banking was, in its initial form, provided for branch banking in Douglas County and those counties contiguous to Douglas County. The vote in Committee was four to four on that basis. An amendment was then offered to make it branch banking in Douglas County only and the Committee vote was still at four and four and the bill did not move. Ultimately, there was an amendment offered to make it branch banking within the city limits, within the metropolitan city of Omaha only and the bill was then advanced to the floor in that condition. I believe that is the only amendment to the bill that prevailed as it came to the floor. So it now would provide for banking within the city of Omaha. I move the adoption of the Committee amendment.
