CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Senator Mahoney voting aye. I will take care of him. Senator Maresh voting aye. Kelly voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Maresh voting aye. Senator Kelly voting aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Duis voting aye. DeCamp and Senator Moylan. Will you announce the vote?

CLERK: 37 ayes, 1 nays, Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The resolution passes. The Chair recognizes Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: May I ask for a suspension of the Rules and the specific rule is up there so that I can be recorded as voting no on LB 383. I move that the Rules be suspended.

SENATOR SAVAGE: There is a motion to suspend the Rules by Senator Marvel. Those for the motion vote aye. Those opposed nay. It takes 30 votes. Will you please vote? Senator Savage voting aye.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Record.

CLERK: 31 ayes, Mr. President.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The Rules are suspended. Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: Is it done?

SENATOR SAVAGE: I am sorry, yes.

SENATOR MARVEL: All right. Thank you.
