SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Senator Kime.

SENATOR KIME: Mr. Chairman, members of the body. I think someone mentioned out over the state there is 93 counties. Ninety-two of these people are outside of Omaha. When we need some extra help out there we just call out to the various ranchers and say "Get on your horse, or whatever you've got, and help us on this". We don't stop to post public notice or anything of that sort. We want help and we want it right now.

To answer Senator Koch's question about money that it will cost out in there, most people don't know this is the information that I get from the Sheriff's Office in Omaha. Most people don't know the men pay their own insurance, pay their own bond and any list here of many of the things that they've done; they've included the dog training, tape recorders, finger print comparison machines, movie equipment, boats, such things as that. They have raised money themselves for repairs of a helicopter that they were using. For support to the Junior Deputy Program they have raised \$29,000. Now that doesn't come out of the county budget. That comes from these special and reserve deputies themselves. This unit has also raised \$10,000 for other things that they use. These people are not paid. The bill designates that they shall be paid \$1 a year, which makes it legal. They go ahead.

I think this bill was illconceived. It will curtail and hold up the actions of the sheriffs throughout the state. It should be All we're asking for is to be bracketed until this other bill is heard.
