PRESIDENT WHELAN: All rise for the morning prayer.

CHAPLAIN: Prayer offered.

PRESIDENT: The Legislature will please come to order.  
Roll call.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Burbach asked to be  
excused until he arrives.

PRESIDENT: Senator Murphy has arrived.

CLERK: He didn't ask anything. Senator Kremer asked to  
be excused on Friday.

PRESIDENT: Have you all recorded your presence for  
purposes of roll call? Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Do you have any corrections in the Journal,  
Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a correction. Yes,  
Mr. President: (Read correction. See page 437, Journal.)  
That is all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Is there any objection to that change? Are  
there further changes in the Journal? Seeing no objections,  
the Journal shall stand as corrected. Committee hearings  
and reports.

CLERK: Mr. President, we have a communication from  
Thurston County Clerk forwarding a Resolution adopted  
by the Thurston County Board of Supervisors expressing  
a position on Legislative Resolution 44. A copy of  
the Resolution has been sent to the Judiciary Committee  
and the original will be on file in my office.  
Mr. President, your Committee on Labor has set hearings

LB 502 and recommend it be replaced on Select File as  
amended; LB 445 replaced on Select File as amended;
