SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, I am.

PRESIDENT: All right. Proceed, Senator.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I have the amendment drawn but for the benefit of the Clerk, on line 3, strike the words "remodel" and "repair". Beginning on line 8, add a comma after "meetings" and strike the words "the bonds shall not constitute a debt of the county or the State of Nebraska" and then on line 12, strike the word "thirty" and add "twenty".

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit, would you be kind enough to write that out so that we have no error here? Senator Schmit, what would your attitude be of going to the next bill and returning immediately to this one? All right. Then you can prepare your amendment so that, we have spent a great deal of time on this and I am sure that you are interested in getting it accurate. With the understanding that we are going to return to LB 519 after we have completed deliberations on LB 434, we now move to LB 434. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 434 introduced by the Committee on Agriculture and Environment. Read title. The bill was first considered April 10th, 1975. It was bracketed. There are Committee amendments by Senator Schmit's Ag Committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: Mr. President, I would like permission to rebracket this bill again for a two week period. The people who are concerned about this bill have asked me not to move on it. Because of their serious concern, I would like to ask to have it bracketed.

PRESIDENT: Request for unanimous consent to bracket this bill for two weeks. Is there an objection? Seeing none, it is so ordered. We return now to LB 519. Do you have a motion, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: On what now?

PRESIDENT: LB 519.

CLERK: Mr. President, there are two amendments now offered to LB 519 by Senator Schmit. Read amendment. See page 577, Journal. Signed Senator Schmit.

PRESIDENT: Senator Schmit.

SENATOR SCHMIT: I move the adoption of the amendments.

CLERK: Is the written amendment the same as the typed amendment, Senator?

SENATOR SCHMIT: Yes, it is. Mr. President, these amendments, and members of the Legislature, these amendments basically correct several of the objections that were most outspoken at the hearing and I believe that the bill was
