SENATOR DUIS: Well, sir,....

CLERK: The motion we have says "add a new section", that's how we construed it.

SENATOR DUIS: You see Section 2 of the bill now merely calls for a repeal of the old Statute. It's subsection 2 of Section 1 that I think that you're interested in.

SENATOR FOWLER: Well what I meant was to ... when I said "add a new section", I'm sorry if the language was not technically correct, was to strike and insert a new Section 2. I would think that the Clerk could change that. The intent was to substitute.

PRESIDENT: The Chair would like to visit with the Clerk for just a few minutes. Thank you. Senator Fowler, perhaps the way out of this is for you to ask unanimous consent to reword your motion which has been adopted to make it conform to your intent and that is to amend Section 2, subsection 1. If that.... Will that do it, Mr. Clerk?

SENATOR FOWLER: I can't hear you, Vince.

CLERK: Do you intend then to strike subsections 3 and 4?

SENATOR FOWLER: I believe the Committee amendment struck Section 3. I intend Section 4 to remain, & for this to be substituted for what is subsection 2.

CLERK: You ask unanimous consent to have us change this to read "an amendment to subsection 2 of Section 1", I think that would take care of it.

SENATOR FOWLER: I would ask unanimous consent for that.

PRESIDENT: Alright, now.... Is there an objection to this request of Senator Fowler? Seeing none, it's so ordered.

CLERK: Now Senator Kelly's amendment.

PRESIDENT: Alright. Senator Nichol. We're now discussing Senator Kelly's amendment.

SENATOR KELLY: I'd rather talk later.

PRESIDENT: I beg your pardon? Oh, Senator Marvel, did you wish to be recognized again? Senator Kelly.

SENATOR KELLY: Mr. President, I would move the adoption of this amendment. It just does away with our ability to attempt to see that far in the future, which I term ridiculous.

PRESIDENT: The question is the adoption of Senator Kelly's amendment. Record your vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays.
