PRESIDENT: There has been a motion that the House go under Call. Record your vote on that matter. Have you voted? Record. The House is under Call.

CLERK: 19 ayes, 3 nays.

PRESIDENT: All Senators are to return to their desks and record your presence, please. I have just sent the Sergeant at Arms to the lounge to get the Senators and he is going to bring back some rolls. Senator Anderson votes aye.

CLERK: Senator Anderson voting aye on the original motion. Senator Savage voting aye on the original motion. Senator Simpson voting aye on the original motion. Senator Johnson changing from no to aye.

PRESIDENT: The question is, shall the Call be raised? All in favor say aye. Contrary say nay. The Call is raised. Report the vote.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 5 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced.

CLERK: Mr. President, may I read in some material.

PRESIDENT: Yes.

CLERK: Mr. President, there is a communication from myself directed to the Governor requesting that he return LB 339 to be inserted in the Journal. See page 666. The next letter is a letter to the Honorable Jules Burbach, Speaker of the Nebraska Legislature. Read. See page 666, Journal.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp, for what purpose do you arise?

CLERK: Let me read in some more.

PRESIDENT: Okay, go ahead.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move that LB 177 become law notwithstanding the action of the Governor. This will be laid over, Mr. President. Signed Senator Luedtke. Mr. President, I move that LB 477 become law notwithstanding the action of the Governor. Signed Senator Swigart. Mr. President, your committee on Appropriations to whom was referred LB 752 instructs me to report the same to General File as amended; LB 756 General File; and LB 115 General File as amended. Signed Senator Marvel. Well, there is some more. LB 684 General File and 916 General File. Signed Senator...916 was from Banking. Mr. President, Education Committee sets LB 995 for hearing. Labor Committee sets LB 1001 for hearing. Senator Keyes asks unanimous consent to print an amendment to LB 786 in the Journal. See page 669. Mr. President, Senator Fowler moves to suspend Rule 3, section 5 so that the Urban Affairs Committee may hold a public hearing on LB 999 on Wednesday, February 18th. Signed Senator Fowler.
