PRESIDENT: Senator Kelly. Would you like to close? Oh, Senator Kelly, oh alright. Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Thank you Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Would you close debate.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Please bear with us, Mr. President. We are preparing an amendment to the amendment. It will be up there in a second.

PRESIDENT: I'm sorry, thank you.

CLERK: Mr. President, I move to amend the Dickinson amendment. On line 11 strike "at the" and insert "prior to". Signed, Senator Stoney.

SENATOR STONEY: Mr. President, members of the body. We felt that with the amendment, as written, it would indicate that at the time of the sale this information had to be divulged. We thought that it would best serve the interests of those purchasers to have this information prior to the time of the sale. We're amending it to add those words "prior to" rather than "at the time of the sale".

PRESIDENT: Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: I have nothing except to move for the adoption of the amendment which Senator Stoney

PRESIDENT: The amendment to the amendment.

SENATOR DICKINSON: The amendment to the amendment, yes.

PRESIDENT: Senator Bereuter's light is on, but I assume he doesn't....

SENATOR DICKINSON: I think he has another brief amendment that will be afterwards. I call for the question.

PRESIDENT: Alright. The question is then... Are you ready for the vote Senator Stoney and Senator Dickinson? The question is the adoption of the amendment to the amendment. Record your vote. Record.

CLERK: 21 ayes, 0 nays.

PRESIDENT: Motion carries. Now we're back on the amendment itself. Senator Bereuter.

SENATOR BEREUTER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I would like to amend the Dickinson amendment. I would appreciate if the Clerk would read the proposed amendment.

CLERK: What the amendment is, Mr. President, is to amend the middle paragraph by inserting "containing current information" in the sentence that reads "the brochures containing current information shall be made available to the general public".
