SENATOR LEWIS: I'd ask that the bill be advanced to E & R Final.

CLERK: Do you want your amendment adopted, Senator?

SENATOR LEWIS: Oh, I would like my amendment adopted.

PRESIDENT: Motion is to adopt Senator Lewis' amendment. Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 28 ayes, 5 nays.

PRESIDENT: The amendment is adopted. Senator Lewis.

SENATOR LEWIS: Now I would ask the bill be advanced to E & R Final.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion. That is the question. Record your vote. Have you all voted? It shows up on my Board. Record.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 6 nays on motion to advance.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. We go back now to General File. Do you have any thing for the record, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: Mr. President, your committee on Judiciary to whom was referred LB 807 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation it be advanced to General File as amended; LB 772 indefinitely postponed. Signed Senator Luedtke, Chairman. Mr. President, your committee on Government, Military and Veterans Affairs reports LB 595 indefinitely postponed; LB 672 indefinitely postponed; LB 767 indefinitely postponed; LB 810 indefinitely postponed; LB 845 indefinitely postponed; LB 885 indefinitely postponed; LB 982 indefinitely postponed. Signed Senator Rasmussen, Chairman. Mr. President, we have one new bill introduced by Senator Frank Lewis. LB 849A. Read title. See page 731, Journal. That is all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: We now move to LB 464.

CLERK: LB 464 introduced by Senator John DeCamp. A bill for an act relating to gambling. Read title. There are Committee amendments by Senator Luedtke's Judiciary Committee.

PRESIDENT: Senator Anderson.

SENATOR ANDERSON: Mr. President, this is a bill that came up last week and we have a similar proposal to the amendments that are on this bill that is before our Committee. We indicated we would like to hold that bill until the Miscellaneous Subjects Committee has had a chance to act on that proposal. We did have an Executive Session yesterday, and because a couple of people were unable to be there, we didn't have the votes to take it up so I would ask that the bill be laid over until Monday and I think the Committee should be able to take care of it today.

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
