PRESIDENT: Roll call vote has been requested. Senator Dickinson. Roll call vote. Well, Senator Lewis, what do you want? Record.

CLERK: Voting aye Senators Barnett, Fitzgerald, Fowler, F. Lewis, Mahoney, Nichol, Rumery, Simpson, Skarda and Syas.

Voting nay Senators Bereuter, Burbach, Burrows, Carsten, Clark, Cope, DeCamp, Dickinson, Duis, Dworak, Hasebroock, Johnson, Kelly, Kennedy, Marsh, Maresh, Marvel, Mills, Moylan, Murphy, Rasmussen, Schmit, Stoney, Stull, Swigart, Warner and Wiltse.

Not voting Senators Anderson, Cavanaugh, Chambers, ....

Senator Savage voting aye. Not voting Senators George, Goodrich, Keyes, Kime, Koch, Kremer, R. Lewis, Luedtke.

PRESIDENT: The amendment fails. Senator Marvel.

CLERK: Now, Mr. President, we have the Committee amendment in its pure form.

SENATOR MARVEL: Shall I proceed with my amendment?

PRESIDENT: Proceed with the Committee amendments, Senator Marvel.

SENATOR MARVEL: The Committee amendment, in effect, reduces the \$42 million to \$40 million and adds \$2 million which is a pay-back to those who ... those counties that contributed to the voch. tech. mill levy, which was declared unconstitutional. I move the adoption of the Committee amendment to 684.

PRESIDENT: Any discussion? You want to close then since there's no lights on?

SENATOR MARVEL: No, Senator Syas has a question.

SENATOR SYAS: How are you going to pay back these mill levy to these people? Do you know who they all are?

SENATOR MARVEL: Senator Syas is asking a question.

SENATOR SYAS: Well I'm just curious.

SENATOR MARVEL: Well I yield to Senator Stull whose amendment this was in Committee.

PRESIDENT: Will you respond, Senator Stull?

SENATOR STULL: Yes. Mr. President, members of the Legislature. These taxes that were paid in, and there is a complete record in each county, and this amendment directs the County Treasurer and the County Assessor to certify the amount that will be due ... that is due to each taxpayer. They certify this to the Tax Commissioner. Then, in turn, the Auditor and the State Tax Commissioner will see ... set up the machinery to pay it back. It's suggested in this
