PRESIDENT: The "A" bill does advance. Now we can go to LB 634.

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature.

PRESIDENT: Excuse me. The Clerk has to read the title, Senator.

CLERK: Read title to LB 634.

PRESIDENT: Senator Rumery.

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. The Department of Administrative Services has prepared a rough draft on the plan for this project. They wanted to check it with the Fiscal Analyst of the Legislatures Office. It is our hope that they'll have copies for each one of the Senators. Could we postpone this, till toward the end of the session, today?

PRESIDENT: Any further discussion? Or what....

SENATOR RUMERY: Mr. President, I don't know what time the Speaker wants to adjourn, but maybe just....

PRESIDENT: Well he hopes to adjourn at 4:30.

SENATOR RUMERY: Let's leave it then bracketed like it is for tomorrow.

PRESIDENT: There's a request for unanimous consent to bracket this bill until tomorrow. Is there an objection? There is an.... Well. Chair recognizes the Speaker.

SPEAKER: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Senator Rumery, I am not going to object at this time. We've moved along rather hastily with our budget bills at this time and these come up very unexpectedly. I would like to continue for approximately another half hour. I know that Senator Koch has a request to hold his. Senator Kremer indicates to me that he is ready. I'd like to say to the body, those of you who have bills on General File and want to list this as a priority, please do so. Either give them to me or to my secretary over in the office. It is vitally important that we consider all of the members of the Legislature with their priority bills, whether they be committee bills or individual bills.

I would urge you that if the bills are in committee, visit with your committee and try to get them out on General File. As soon as they are on General File come to me or to my secretary. We will list these bills.

I want to apologize. I don't want anyone to think that this was done intentionally. If you look under number 14, 922 is a bill introduced by Senator Maresh. Senator Johnson has made the request for that. I'm sure we won't get to it today. However, that must be stricken from your list as it is not on General File at the moment yet. This is an error. LB 922. It is an error on my part and I want to admit it and accept the responsibility for that being placed there in error.
