SENATOR F. LEWIS: Unanimous consent to bracket the bill.

PRESIDENT: Indefinitely?

SENATOR F. LEWIS: Yes.

PRESIDENT: Is there an objection? Seeing none, the bill is indefinitely bracketed. LB 451.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 451 is a bill introduced by Senator Johnson. Read title. Mr. President, the bill was first considered on January 14th, at which time, it failed to advance. There are no Committee amendments or other amendments pending. Senator Johnson.

PRESIDENT: Senator Johnson. The Chair recognizes Senator Johnson.

SENATOR JOHNSON: Mr. President, I ask to pass over that now.

PRESIDENT: I beg your pardon?

SENATOR JOHNSON: I ask to pass over that now.

PRESIDENT: Mr. Speaker, what happens to a passed over on General File, then? You mean, it goes to the bottom of the heap?

SENATOR BURBACH: It has to go to the bottom of the heap. It cannot...we have only got 21 days left and I hesitate to do this but it is the only thing we can do.

PRESIDENT: All right. Fine. Senator Keyes, do you still wish to be recognized? All right. LB 752. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, there was a missignal between Senator Lewis and I on LB 167. He asked unanimous consent to bracket it, and before I could object, it was bracketed. So since it was no time certain, I am going to ask unanimous consent to unbracket it for the purpose of amending the bill.

PRESIDENT: All right. Is there an objection of Senator Chambers' request. The point is, is there an objection? There is an objection, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Then, in order that there be a discussion, I move that LB 167 be unbracketed. I started to say objected to. I make that motion. Why can't I make that motion, Senator Syas, Chairman Syas, Dean of the Legislature? Is the motion out of order?

PRESIDENT: It sort of defeats the purpose of the Speaker's daily order. Having bracketed it, we have got to move on to other things but could I inquire, what happened between you and Senator Lewis that you couldn't get this on when it was up?
