CLERK: LR 124 calls for an interim study committee of the Banking and Insurance Committee.

Your committee on Miscellaneous Subjects to whom is referred LB881 instructs me to report the same to the Legislature the recommendation be advanced to General File. Signed, Senator Anderson.

Mr. President your committee on Revenue to whom LB863 was referred to instructs me to report the same to the Legislature that it be advanced to General File, Signed, Senator Carsten, Chairman.

Mr. President, the Public Health and Welfare Committee announces an Executive Session at 1:00 today under the north balcony. Signed, Senator Kennedy, Chairman.

Mr. President, the next matter to come up are amendments offered by Senator Kennedy's Health Committee.

PRESIDENT: The Chair recognizes Senator Kennedy.

SENATOR KENNEDY: Mr. President, I would move that we adopt...Mr. President, fellow members of the Legislature, I would move that we adopt the committee amendments. Actually the committee amendments would be a combination of the rewrite the white bill and also as printed in your Journal two brief amendments that would change the language in relative to the composition of the Board of Directors authority to leave it to read merely that the board will consist of seven members appointed by the Governor with the consent of the Legislature and the second amendment would change the per diem to be \$30 a month. I would move for the adoption of the committee amendments.

PRESIDENT: Senator....
