he arrives. Senator Skarda asked to be excused.

PRESIDENT: Record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: A quorum present, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Corrections to the Journal.

CLERK: Read corrections. See page 998, Journal.  
That is all, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Correct what? How did that mistake get  
in the Journal? Mr. Clerk, I think the Legislature  
deserves an explanation of that. Are there other  
corrections? The Journal shall stand.

CLERK: Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: Committee hearings and reports.

CLERK: Mr. President, a communication from the  
Governor's office under date of March 8th addressed  
to Vincent Brown, Clerk of the Legislature. Read

Mr. President, there will be inserted in the Journal  
a copy of a Resolution passed by the State of New  
Mexico Legislature dealing with the urging of  
Congress to pass a constitutional amendment or to  
refer a constitutional amendment to the people regarding  
a restriction on federal expenditures. The Resolution  
will be on file in my office if anybody desires to see  
it. Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk reports that
