CLERK: Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk reports that she on this day did present to the Governor LB634, 652, 692, 786, 795, 795A, signed, Barbara Jackson, Enrolling Clerk.

PRESIDENT: We now go to General File. LB631.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB631 was first considered yesterday the title was read the committee amendments were offered and are pending. The last action we had was the rejection of the Cavanaugh amendment. There is now another amendment to the committee amendments to amend...(read amendment).

PRESIDENT: Chair recognizes Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. It is just a clarifying sentence to pin down specifically why they may go over their spending limitations. I think that it just clarifies that and hopefully it will pass. I move for the adoption of this amendment.

PRESIDENT: Senator Dworak.

SENATOR DWORAK: Is this amendment in the Journal? Are these amendments that Senator Koch has introduced available?

CLERK: The Koch amendments are in the Journal, but the Dickinson one isn't. The Koch amendments are in the Bill Book. They are committee amendments.

SENATOR DWORAK: Okay, but is Senator Dickinson's...the one that we are discussing, is that available?

CLERK: Not in the Journal. All it reads is that page 2, strike line 26 and insert "Busing ordered by Federal Courts of Integration purposes."

PRESIDENT: Are you ready for the question? Senator Dickinson I am about to put the question to the body. Senator Dickinson.

SENATOR DICKINSON: Senator Barnett, do you have a question? It simply clarifies the language on line 26, page 2 of the committee amendments...
