PRESIDENT: We're under Call.

CLERK: Senator Carsten voting aye. Senator Johnson voting aye.

SENATOR F. LEWIS: I move the Call be raised, Mr. President.

PRESIDENT: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye, contrary say nay. The Call is raised. Report the vote Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 11 nays.

PRESIDENT: The bill is advanced. We have with us, in the North balcony, a large group of junior high students from Central High in Omaha. This is the first of three groups. Mr. President, an explanation of vote by Senator Wiltse. Had he been present he would have voted aye to indefinitely postpone LB 409.

Mr. President, Senator Kremer and R. Lewis asked to be excused from 11 till noon. Senator Skarda and Mahoney asked to be excused at noon.

Mr. President, your Committee Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 764 and find the same correctly engrossed. Signed, Senator Dworak, Chairman.
