SENATOR SAVAGE: Chair recognizes Senator Simpson.

SENATOR SIMPSON: Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I think I too would support this. The only problem I have in doing this is reading in the Rag from the University that the Appropriations Committee took this up and turned it down. I think it's unfortunate that we get this kind of wording going back to the University students that we are doing this when I never had it before me as a member of the Appropriations Committee as to whether we should accept this or not. So I'm surely going to vote for it now.

SENATOR SAVAGE: There's no further discussion. Senator Chambers, do you wish to close on your motion?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. Chairman, for the sake of the record I want to read the narrative that would be included. "It is the intent of the Legislature that if federal funds for the support of the Special Services Program as identified by the University in the 1976-'77 budget request become available to the Office of Minority Affairs on the UNL campus, such funds shall offset General Funds. These remaining General Funds shall lapse on June 30, 1977" so there is no way there can be double funding. If the federal money comes the state money goes back.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The question is the adoption of the Chambers amendment. All in favor vote aye, all opposed vote nay. Will you please vote.

CLERK: Senator Savage voting aye.

SENATOR SAVAGE: Have you all voted? Please vote. Have you all voted? Clerk will record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 2 nays, Mr. President, on motion to adopt.

SENATOR SAVAGE: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a series of things to read into the Journal. Senator Richard Lewis asks unanimous consent to print amendments to 806.

Mr. President, your Enrolling Clerk reports that she did, on this day, present to the Governor 634A and 869.
