CLERK: Mr. President, Senator George asks unanimous consent to print amendments to LB 690. Mr. President, your committee on Enrollment and Review reports we have examined and reviewed LB 176 and recommend it be replaced on Select File as amended. Mr. President, your committee on Education to whom was referred LB 173, 364, 456, 462, 648, 726, 754 and 755 recommend all be indefinitely postponed. Mr. President, LR 134 is ready for the President's signature. Mr. President, I ask to be excused for an hour from 3:30 to 4:30, signed Senator Warner.

PRESIDENT: While the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I did sign legislative resolution 134.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kennedy asked to be excused at 4:30. That's all Mr. President. Now we have a motion to return LB 204 to Select File for a specific amendment. Signed Senator Cavanaugh. What this specific amendment is is the last half of the Goodrich amendment previously offered.

PRESIDENT: Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Well, this is the wine amendment and I assume that the reason it wasn't successful is because of Senator Goodrich's amendment so I would appreciate having the bill returned and this amendment attached. There really isn't any good reason that I know of to have beer between the hours of 6:00 and 6:00 on Sunday and not allow wine. This doesn't expand any license privileges or anything. It simply allows that you can have wine with your meal in a restaurant on Sunday and I think there shouldn't be any controversy about that. Move that the bill be returned.

PRESIDENT: Senator George.

SENATOR GEORGE: Mr. President, can we talk to the liquid substance right now or just to the return of the bill?

PRESIDENT: Well, it's been our custom to discuss the amendment itself on the motion to return.

SENATOR GEORGE: Thank you. I just wanted to remind the body that yesterday we were celebrating the Irish, we do have a number of Italian restaurants in Omaha and beer is just the wrong kind of liquid with their food so let's have them serve their red liquid with it. I am supporting it, in other words, Senator Cavanaugh's amendment.

PRESIDENT: The question is, the re...shall the bill be returned for the specific amendment. Record your vote. Please vote. Please vote. Record.

CLERK: 25 ayes, 8 nays, 16 not voting to return.

PRESIDENT: The bill is returned, Senator Cavanaugh.

SENATOR CAVANAUGH: Move that the amendment be adopted.

PRESIDENT: Discussion? Record your vote. Please vote. Record.
