CLERK: 31 ayes, 8 nays, 10 not voting to cease debate.

PRESIDENT: Senator DeCamp.

SENATOR DeCAMP: Mr. President, the issue is clear - do we deal with malpractice or not. This appears to be the only way.

PRESIDENT: The question is the suspension of the rules. Would you read the rules to be suspended, Senator ... or Mr. Brown.

CLERK: Suspend Rule 7, Sec. 3(D), Rule 5, Sec. 2(B) to allow the amendments offered by Senator Schmit to be offered as a substitute amendment to 434.

PRESIDENT: Record your vote. Have you all voted? Record.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 7 nays, 4 not voting.

PRESIDENT: The rules are suspended. So that the Chair's position is completely clear in this, suspension of the rules does not clear up all constitutional questions in the regard of introduction of bills.

Read the two letters.

CLERK: Mr. President, a communication from the Executive Office under date of March 18th, addressed to Vincent Brown, Clerk of the Legislature. (Read communication found on page 1241 of the Journal regarding LB 861 and 634A).
